****Underline indicates technique on which each class will primarily be judged.**

1. Hand knitted jumper or cardigan in wool, wool mix or natural fibre.
2. Child's matinee jacket knitted in wool or wool mixture.
3. Child's matinee jacket crochet in wool or wool mixture.
4. Shawl/rug knitted or crochet. 1st \$20 voucher, **Donated by Joy's Craftworx, Portland.**
5. One piece cotton crochet work.
6. Any article knitted or crocheted not already mentioned.
7. Article in counted cross-stitch.
8. Article of quilting, hand or machine.
9. Article of tapestry.
10. Embroidered toy.
11. Article of creative embroidery may incorporate mixed media, fibres or techniques.
12. Article of applique.
13. Large article of patchwork, e.g. bed quilt.
14. Small article of patchwork, e.g. cushion, vest etc.
15. Decorated coat hanger.
16. Decorated cushion.
17. Article of fancywork from recycled materials. Exhibitor to state origin of materials and recycling process.
18. Article of smocking. Special by Mrs. M. Smith.
19. Any article of needlework, not already mentioned.
20. Machine made garment, any fabric.
21. Machine made garment - stretch fabric.
22. Machine made garment any fabric, 16 years and under.
23. Article constructed from not more than one metre of gingham.

****Note rules for the following Classes (24, 25, 26, 27 & 28):** Must be bonafide work of the exhibitor and must be made from wool or wool blend (is wool blended with any other product - acrylic, silk, angora, etc.) stipulated with label attached, or label or receipt from woollen mill (Class 24 & 28).

The winners are expected to compete at the Tyrendarra Show Group Final on 9th February, 2013. An exhibitor may represent only one Society at Group Level and one Group at State Level. 1st \$3.

24. V.A.S. Ltd. with Hand Knitted Jumper or Cardigan made from pure new "Wool Yarn" or "Wool Blend" any ply.
25. V.A.S. Ltd. with Patchwork Competition: A piece of Patchwork, no more than 1 metre on any side, machine pieced and machine quilted, no embellishments.
26. Spotlight State Sewing Competition: The garment/outfit to be made by the exhibitor.

Garment/outfit of wearing apparel (maximum 3 pieces). Sewn by machine. May be hand finished. Accessories such as scarves, stoles, shawls, gloves etc. are not acceptable. Knitted/crocheted items not acceptable.

28. VAS Ltd Crochet Competition - Crocheted article made from pure wool/ wool blend of any ply.
