CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Entries may be in colour or monochrome, must be no larger than 20 cm x 30 cm must be mounted (mount no larger than 3 cms) but NOT framed.

Limit 3 entries per exhibitor.

Local Level 1st \$5.00,

Open Section

1. Any subject in Colour.
2. Any subject in Monochrome (including black and white or sepia).
3. Portrait of one or more people.
4. Must include a Door
5. Anything in the Glenelg Shire.
6. Seascape or Landscape.
7. Cemeteries
8. Macro, the subject should appear larger than in real life.
9. Automobiles/Transport.
10. Silhouette - the dark shape of someone or something visible in restricted light against a brighter background. Achieved by shooting at fast shutter speeds into light.
11. Triptych - 3 photos with a common theme, preferably displayed on the same mount. Each photo to be no larger than 5" x 7" (3 cm x 8 cm). If in doubt, contact steward.
12. Reflection. Something that is a reflection of an object or person.
13. Boat/s.

Junior Section (Under 18)

1. Any subject in Colour.
2. Any subject in Monochrome/Sepia, shades of one colour, includes black and white.
3. Garden.
4. Sports/Play.
5. Hobbies/Toy Story
6. Animals.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Maximum size of photograph 30.5 cm x 37.5 cm (2 ins. x 5 ins.) Maximum mount size 36 cms x 42.5 cms (4 ins x 7 ins). ALL PHOTOS TO BE FIRMLY FIXED TO MOUNT BOARD/CARDBOARD - NO GLASS OR WOODEN FRAMES ACCEPTED. For further advice contact the senior stewards.
2. A maximum of three Photographs per exhibitor per subject.
3. Exhibitors in the Junior Section may also enter the Open Section if they wish.
4. Entries must be clearly identified on the reverse side with the exhibitor's name, the section and subject number.
