All rams must be from an accredited Brucellosis free flock.

Ovine Johne's Disease. Every precaution will be taken to enable exhibitors to return their sheep to the property of origin with no detriment to their Ovine Johnes disease status. The grounds will be inspected.

No sheep to compete in more than one class excepting group or otherwise stated.

Entries will be accepted up till 10 a.m. on Show Day with the respective Senior Stewards. Entry Fee \$2.

The Champion Ram and Ewe in each breed will receive a trophy valued at \$20 and a champion sash.

The Tyrendarra P. & A. Society holds a current Certificate of Compliance under the Australian Bovine Johnes Disease Market Assurance Program (B.J.D.M.A.P). This allows both assessed and non-assessed cattle to be handled and exhibited on show day in separate areas. MN accredited exhibitors need to bring a copy of current certificate PIC-3GLXK063.

Exhibitors are required to complete a Johnes Disease Health Status Declaration **prior to show day**. A copy of the declaration is obtainable from the Show Secretary and is to be returned to either the Secretary or the Chief Cattle Steward.

All cattle MUST carry an NLIS Tag.

All exhibited cattle are to be registered with their breed society (unless otherwise stated) and shall be shown in accordance with their breed society's rules. All exhibits must be halter led. Bulls over 2 months must be rung and all bulls must be tethered by a suitable neck strap. Ramps, washing and watering facilities available.

A FLEECE CAN BE ENTERED IN ONE CLASS ONLY

Entries close at 10.30 a.m. Sharp.

All fleeces to be judged under N.C.W.S.B. points system.

Entry Fee \$1. Prizes - 1st \$7 or trophy, 2nd \$2, unless otherwise stated.

Entries with fees, to be lodged with Senior Steward on Show Day. All fleeces to be skirted to the satisfaction of the judge. Any fleece in the opinion of the judge to be in the wrong class, will be placed in its correct class, and judged in such class.

No skirtings required in any class.

Fleeces to be shorn during the previous season, and not exceed 55 weeks' growth.

1. Skirted Merino Fleece, rams excluded, 16.4 micron & finer.
2. Skirted Merino Fleece, rams excluded, 16.5 to 8.5 micron.
3. Skirted Merino Fleece, rams excluded, 18.6 to 2.0 micron.
4. Skirted Merino Fleece, rams excluded 21.1 micron & broader.
5. Skirted Merino Weaners Fleece.
6. Skirted Merino Rams Fleece.
7. Skirted Corriedale Fleece, rams excluded.
8. Skirted Corriedale Weaners Fleece.
9. Skirted Corriedale Rams Fleece.
10. Skirted Crossbred Fleece, finer than 27.9 micron.
11. Skirted Crossbred Fleece, stronger than 28 micron.
12. Most Valuable Fleece.
13. Lambs Fleece - any breed.
